★ **Tickets are selling out FAST, and some shows are close to selling out!** The Scout Show is completely sold out, and the School Show has very limited space available! **Performances begin on December 6th and run through December 17th.** Purchase your tickets today!

★ Don't forget to join us for the **Cast Party, happening on December 16th** in between shows. Dancers in the cast attend for free. Come celebrate the end of a successful production!

★ **Show your dancer appreciation with a rose!** A limited number of roses will be available for purchase in the lobby for you to give to your dancer at each public performance. Please note that there will be no backstage deliveries for any roses purchased.

★ Dress Rehearsals are on **Monday, December 4th** for dancers in Cast A and **Tuesday, December 5th** for dancers in Cast B.



★ **Cherish the memories from this year's production by purchasing professional photos and/or a DVD/Blu-Ray.** *PBM Images* will be taking photos during the dress rehearsals, and *Video Connections* will be recording both Cast A and Cast B during the performances. Spring Enrollment Information

Believe it or not, Spring 2018 enrollment is right around the corner! **Current students' spots are held in their current class(es) for the first two weeks of enrollment only.** After that, all classes are open to both new and current students. **If you would like to make an adjustment to your current ballet schedule, be sure to stop by the office during the first two weeks of enrollment and put your dancer's name on a wait list for another class day or time.** As always, families must have a zero balance on their account in order to enroll in the next semester. Enrollment can be done in person with cash (no bills over \$50), check, or card, or over the phone paying the full balance with card only. **Be sure to enroll during the first two weeks to guarantee your dancer's spot!** If you have any questions about enrollment, please call, email, or stop by the office!

Teacher's Corner: Miss Danika's Performance Tips

With *The Nutcracker* coming up in just one week, we wanted to share with you some useful tips for when you finally get to take the stage!

- 1. Come prepared:** It is important to check your ballet bag before each and every dress rehearsal and performance to make sure you have everything you need. Make sure you have clean tights, make-up, bobby pins, hair-nets, **your ballet/pointe shoes**, and of course a healthy snack, and anything else you need for the show.
- 2. Review your choreography:** Before you go on stage, it is always a good idea to find a quiet place to walk through all of your steps. This can help you focus before a performance, and help ensure that you do your very best job on stage!
- 3. Get rest when you can:** 10 performances of *The Nutcracker* is a huge undertaking, even for a professional dancer. It is important to get as much sleep as possible in between shows, and take care of your body, icing any part of your body that is starting to bother you and taking preventative steps to make sure you don't end up with an injury.
- 4. ENJOY YOURSELF!** You have worked hard for the past 10 weeks, and it is finally your time to shine on stage! It is an amazing feeling to dance in bright lights in front of a big audience, and you deserve to have a great time up there! Great work!
